3. Child Protection Issue

Please note the suspension of the following individuals,

The terms of the suspension are that:-

- They must not participate in any football activity involving children under the age of 16 years.
- Activity includes managing, coaching, refereeing, playing, undertaking administrative duties, transportation on behalf of the club (other than in relation to his own children) or any other activity which brings him into contact with children under the age of 16.
- The suspension does not prohibit attendance as a spectator.
- The suspension does not prohibit involvement in adult football.

Please note that information regarding the suspension is confidential and should only be communicated on a 'need to know' basis.

5. Rule 10B

Please note that Rule 10B has been implemented for all Selkent League Competition games from Under 9 to Under 16.

Where a team with a home fixture is unable to provide a pitch or the pitch is unfit, the Fixtures Secretary may order the match to be played on the opponents pitch or an alternative nominated pitch if, in his opinion, such action is necessary for the orderly completion of league, cup or trophy matches.

The Management Committee shall have the power to decide whether a pitch and/or facilities are suitable for matches in the league and to order the Club concerned to play its fixtures on another ground. Any dispute relating to re-arranged games or decisions related to unplayed games will be referred to Management Committee.

Please note that a separate form must be completed for each team making an application into the Selkent Youth League.
